1 We have heard Mr. B.S. Khatana, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Parth Bhatt, learned AGP for respondent no.1, Mr. B.N. Vaishnav, learned counsel for respondent no.2 and Mr. K.S. Nanavati, learned Sr. Advocate assisted by Mr. Nandish Chudgar and Mr. Raheel Patel, advocates for Nanavati Associates for respondent no.5.

2 It is stated by the learned counsel that since the petitioner Panchayat is one of the branches of the government and the dispute as regards the illegal mining is raised against the other department of the government, the petitioner wants to sort out the dispute by approaching the internal mechanism before the government by making suitable representation. The petitioner is at liberty to make representation before the appropriate authority. It is needless to say that the concerned government department will decide the aforesaid dispute in accordance with law.

3 In view of the aforesaid position, we deem it proper to dispose of the present petition for taking appropriate action departmentally before the appropriate authority.

4 The petition is disposed of accordingly. Notice is discharged. No costs.
